Subject: River Updates for Brazoria County

Brazoria County – The rivers have not been affected by the rainfall over the last couple of days as predicted. This has been reflected in the lowering of the projected crest on the Brazos and San Bernard Rivers. County Officials will continue to monitor the rivers and the weather as more rain is forecasted through Saturday.

The Brazos River at Rosharon is expected to crest Friday night and remain at 51.4' until Sunday morning, May 12, and will start a slow descent. The Brazos at West Columbia will crest on Sunday, May 12 at 29', which is one foot below flood stage, and also will begin a moderate descent. The San Bernard River is also expected to crest on Sunday, May 12, at 21.1' at Old Ocean, with a rapid descent.

Residents need to continue to monitor the river levels. Rain is in the forecast for our area, and residents are encouraged to be weather aware.
