Subject: Brazoria County River Update

Brazoria County – County Officials are staying abreast on river and weather conditions from the National Weather Service. The Brazos River at Rosharon crested at 51.4’ Friday night on May 10, and has fallen thus far to 51.32’, and will continue a slow descent as we head into next week. The Brazos River at West Columbia is forecasted to crest on Sunday, May 12 at 28.5’ and will start a decline. The San Bernard River at Old Ocean will crest overnight at 14.9’ and will have a sharp decline on Sunday. According to the National Weather Service, no substantial rainfall is in the forecast within the next few days that will affect the river levels.
