

**Brazoria County Parks Policy:**

***Length of stay for a Recreational Vehicle in a campsite inside San Luis Pass County Park***

In order to better serve all would-be park visitors and campers, ensure ultimate safety of all park guests and properties, and to preserve San Luis Pass County Park as a public access recreational park, a new policy is henceforth enacted regarding length of stay for recreational vehicles:

Any recreational vehicle that is parked inside San Luis Pass County Park may stay for a maximum duration of 90 days or three months. Once an RV has camped for 90 days inside the park (occupying any campsite), it must be moved from the campsite and transported to another location outside of the park property boundary. Then, that RV and its occupants may not return to San Luis Pass County Park as overnight campers for a period of at least 90 consecutive days.

This 90-day campsite length-of-stay cap applies to either scenario of 90 consecutive days, or an aggregate of 90 days cumulative within a calendar year (Jan.-Dec). Once the 90 day length-of-stay cap has been reached, and once the recreational vehicle has left the park for a period of 90 days lapsed time, the recreational vehicle and its occupants are eligible to occupy an RV campsite once again at San Luis Pass County Park, subject to availability, but may stay no longer than an additional 90 days.

The 90-day length-of-stay cap and 90-day time lapse for return policies may be modified or extended with authorization from the Brazoria County Parks Director, San Luis Pass County Park Manager, or his or her designee: such as, during the off-peak months of October through February stays may extend up to 150 days, but only for limited campsites, on a case-by-case basis, and subject to availability and discretion of Park staff.

Compliance with the 90-day length-of-stay policy is in addition to other Brazoria County ordinances, regulations and policies regarding recreational vehicles, which state that all RVs must be road worthy and maintain current registration.
