Quintana Beach County Park Day-Use Area Rules

So that everyone may have a safe and pleasant day at the park; The following rules are <u>STRICTLY</u> enforced:

- ALL DAY-USE GUESTS MUST EXIT THE PARK BEFORE DARK
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS allowed in the park or on the beach. \$500 FINE
- NO public display or <u>public consumption of alcohol</u> while on Park premises. Alcoholic beverages must be put in unmarked containers (Cup or Koozie).
- <u>NO</u> open flame of any kind, including campfires, grills, camp stoves or torches on the beach, pavilions, boardwalk or picnic tables. Grills used in the day-use area must be at ground level, 10 feet from boardwalk. Propane cookers with an open flame are not permitted. All fires are subject to local burn bans.
- Pets must be physically restrained at ALL times. Leashes must be 8 feet or less. Owner MUST clean up droppings and/or other messes made by pets.
- NO use of metal detectors inside Park property. All articles, artifacts, plants, animals, stone, sand, metal or other minerals or items should not be removed from Park property.
- NO fireworks of any kind in the park or on the beach. Possession of firearms is subject to applicable state laws, and all valid permits for open carry (LTC) and concealed carry (CHL) are required.
- NO camping or camp tents on the beach or in the day-use area. EZ-up shelters are permitted for day use.
- NO generators in the park or on the beach.
- DO NOT walk over or climb on sand dunes, as these are protected habitats by the State of Texas.
- NO 4-wheelers, ATV's, dirt bikes etc. permitted in the park, on the beach or on the dunes.
- <u>DO NOT</u> tie or otherwise fasten tarps, awnings, hammocks, etc. to the boardwalk or any other structure in the park, including beach structures. DO NOT "claim" covered benches by placing personal belongings on or around them.
- <u>DO NOT</u> move picnic tables.
- Please demonstrate respect for all fish and wildlife species, as this park is their home, and people are the guests. For the safety of our marine wildlife, balloons of any kind are not allowed. Statewide fishing license, length and bag limit requirements apply to all fishing done at Brazoria County beaches.
- Please show courtesy toward all other park guests. Bad, inappropriate, profane, lewd, drunken, unlawful or otherwise undesirable behavior will not be tolerated. Brazoria County Parks are intended to be safe, family-oriented environments, and will be preserved as such at all times. Inappropriate conduct will result in expulsion from the park.
- PLEASE keep your park clean and dispose of litter properly. We offer free trash bags on request.
