What is CISM?

Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) is a crisis intervention and peer support program developed for emergency responders. Teams provide resources and one on one Peer Support/CISM interventions to first responders and veterans in need. The program contains different levels of interventions designed for the specific needs of the responder or veteran, the responder's family, and/or the need of the unit/agency.

Benefits of CISM Include:

Maintain health and productivity \cdot Prevent traumatic stress effects \cdot Restore personnel to normal functions \cdot Enhance the overall environment in which the person lives and works \cdot Opportunity for expression \cdot Crisis Education
