What is CISM?

Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) is a crisis intervention and peer support program developed for emergency responders. Teams provide resources and one on one Peer Support/CISM interventions to first responders and veterans in need. The program contains different levels of interventions designed for the specific needs of the responder or veteran, the responder's family, and/or the need of the unit/agency.

Maintain health and productivity · Prevent traumatic stress effects · Restore personnel to normal functions · Enhance the overall environment in which the person lives and works · Opportunity for expression · Crisis Education
