## Site-specific campsite rules for Hanson-Beal Park

Primitive campsites must be paid in full online prior to arrival, no walk-in reservations.

Reservations are available for up to 7 days max, 7 days between stays.

Only 6 people per site, unless all members are of a single family.

Tent campsites do not have water, electricity, or onsite shower facilities. Potable water is available at the park office.

All garbage must be placed in the dumpster adjacent to the Park HQ Office.

The parking lot for campsites is located at restrooms, additional parking at park office. The road to the restrooms is one lane, but two-way traffic.

If you need help shuttling gear to your campsite you must pre-arrange transport with park staff prior to arrival. Shuttle services are available between 8 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., 7 days a week.

Park staff is not available after closing, check-In for campers is between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. only. If you plan to arrive after 4:00pm please let us know. (park staff will not be available)

Hanson-Beal Park closes at dusk each day. No hiking or trail biking after dark.

Quiet time for all campsites is 10 p.m. daily.

Public display or consumption of alcohol is prohibited.

Campfires in fire rings only.

No motorized vehicles beyond the parking lot is allowed.

No BBQ pits, no portable toilets, no black or grey water allowed in the park.

No cutting of firewood from trees; only downed limbs can be gathered.
