ARIDE bridges the gap between the SFST and DEC/DRE programs, providing officers with general knowledge related to drug impairment and promoting the use of DREs. Officers are trained to observe, identify, and articulate the signs of impairment related to alcohol, drugs, or a combination of both, to reduce the number of impaired driving incidents and serious injury and fatal crashes.

Training Topics:

Introduction and Overview of Drugs and Highway Safety Observations of Eyes and other Sobriety Tests Effects of Drug Combinations SFST Update, Review, and Proficiency Examination Seven Drug Categories Pre- and Post-Arrest Procedures

*This is not a basic level course. Participants are required to pass an SFST proficiency in order to remain and receive credit.

Completion of the NHTSA Standardized Field Sobriety Testing Practitioner Course, 2176 or 2067; or taken in Academy.
