Applicant further agrees that the maximum front axle load will be 14,000 lbs. The maximum load for all other axles will be 17,000 lbs. and the total maximum load will not exceed 80,000 lbs.


Applicant further agrees that should additional road surfacing materials or reinforcement to existing bridges and structures be required by the Applicant, that this work will be done entirely at the expense of the Applicant and under the direction of the County Engineer.

Applicant further agrees to comply with the Uniform Traffic Act of the State of Texas, and laws of the State of Texas, in operating under this permit, and he further represents that he has complied with the financial responsibility provisions of the laws of the State of Texas and all other enactment's governing an operation of this kind, and the rules and regulations of Brazoria County governing such roads.

corporation duly licensed to do business in the State of Texas, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto Brazoria County, Texas, called "Obligee," in the penal sum of Five Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00), to the payment of which sum, well and truly to be make to Brazoria County Judge or his successors and assigns, the said Principal and Surety to hereby bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, jointly and severally.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that the said Principal will make payment to Brazoria County, Texas, within thirty (30) days of demand, of and for any and all damages that may be sustained to any road, bridge or other structure under the jurisdiction of Brazoria County, Texas, by virtue of the operation of any equipment by the said Principal, his agents, employees, or subcontractors, for which a permit is issued to operate.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall pay to Brazoria County, Texas, any and all damages that may be sustained to any road, bridge or other structure as above recited by virtue of the operation of any equipment between the date of issuance of this bond and the expiration date of principal's permit from Brazoria County, pursuant to said permit, then this obligation to be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
