Prison Rape Elimination Act 2016-2017 Annual Report

The Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department (BCJJD) is dedicated to meeting the requirements of the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) of 2003 and the department seeks to improve and continually refine safety and security practices for all BCJJD detainees as a result thereof. This report is a summary of the agency's efforts in PREA compliance. By compiling, reviewing and implementing corrective actions based on agency data relating to sexual abuse and sexual harassment the BCJJD seeks to increase the effectiveness of sexual abuse and sexual harassment prevention, detection, response, investigations, monitoring technology, area examinations, staffing levels, trainings, policies and procedures.

Purpose:

This document serves as an annual review to assess and improve the effectiveness of sexual abuse and sexual harassment prevention, detection, and response while examining policies, practices, systems and training in the Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department (BCJJD), pursuant to \$115.388 and \$115.389 of the national PREA standards. Therein, BCJJD is required to:

- 1. Review and aggregate incident-based sexual abuse data annually in order to improve the effectiveness of sexual abuse prevention, detection and response policies, practices and training to include:
 - a. Identifying problem areas;
 - b. Taking corrective action on an on-going basis; and
 - c. Preparing an annual report of its findings
- 2. Compare the current year's data and corrective actions with those from prior year's and provide an assessment of the agency's progress in addressing sexual abuse.
- 3. Publish the annual report on the Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department website of its findings and corrective actions for the agency as a whole.

Aggregated Data:

The Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department collects data from both incidents and investigations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment in the following categories: youth-on-youth, youth-on-staff and staff-on-youth. The data in the section below contains aggregated data from CY2016 and CY2017 (Calendar Year = CY) up to June 2017.

All sexual abuse and sexual harassment allegations are compiled, reviewed, documented and stored in a secured area. All incidents of abuse are reported to the following agencies: Texas Department of Family and Protective Services, Texas Juvenile Justice Department and local law enforcement authorities. The following table below depicts a breakdown of our 2016-2017 sexual abuse and sexual harassment data as of June 2017 in the following categories: youth-on-youth, youth-on-staff and staff-on-youth. The data below includes all sexual abuse and sexual harassment allegations from the Brazoria County Juvenile Justice Department.

orrective Areas and Corrective Actions Taken

pon aggregating the data of CY2016-CY2017 there were a few corrective areas that needed to be addressed. Policy 1.22 Resident ygiene and Detention Orientation Rules and Regulations were updated to include increased security measures that ensure sexual afety for all of our youth and staff. All forms created during the CY2015-CY2016 audit cycle are fully integrated into the department nd being utilized to meet PREA standards. The departments staffing plan has been updated to display changes within the agency. CJJD is continuously updating our PREA training curriculum for staff and residents to ensure a clear understanding of sexual afety in the department. No corrective actions were needed towards any BCJJD physical plant areas during CY2016-CY2017.

- Revised Policy 1.22 Resident Personal Hygiene/Showers/Towels / Bedding/Clothing
- Revised Detention Orientation Rules and Regulations
- Updates to PREA Training for staff and residents

ne BCJJD continues to implement best practices to meet and exceed the requirements of the PREA standards in order to address llegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment for residents and staff. All BCJJD administrative members are committed to roviding continual monitoring while implementing corrective actions in order to reach full PREA compliance. Overall, the BCJJD is progressively taking strides in the right direction geared toward exceeding the intent of the PREA standards.
