

BRAZORIA COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT
DAY-USE PARK RULES

1. Area used must be cleaned upon departure.
2. No glass containers allowed.
3. Fires or grills allowed in designated areas only.
4. Park in designated areas only.
5. Pets must be kept on leash.
6. Groups greater than 50 persons serving alcohol must provide security one hour before the event and until all guests have left the premises. No public display or public consumption of alcohol while on Park premises. Please put alcoholic beverages in unmarked containers.
7. Volleyball & basketball courts – first come, first served.
8. No inflatables. (moonwalks, bouncy houses, water slides, etc.)
9. No water activities.
10. Excessive, loud music not allowed.
11. Possession of firearms is subject to applicable state laws, and all valid permits for open carry (LTC) and concealed carry (CHL) are required.
12. Permit required in advance for any sales made in our parks. Contact the office for details.
13. Please demonstrate respect for all fish and wildlife species, as this park is their home, and people are the guests. Statewide fishing license, length and bag limit requirements apply.
14. All interpretation of park rules is subject to discretion of Park staff—who represent the final authority and jurisdiction while visitors remain on park property.
15. No overnight camping is allowed at public boat ramps or inside Park day-use areas.
16. Park closes at dusk.

A BRAZORIA COUNTY PARK RANGER MAY MAKE AN INITIAL CONTACT WITH THE RESERVATION PARTY AT THE STARTING TIME OF THE EVENT AND AGAIN AT THE END OF THE EVENT.

Guests must report a cancellation to the Admin Office 72 hours before their reservation to receive a refund.
Approved reschedule due to weather must be used within 60 days.
